

Will of Abraham Bullock 1806

In The Name of God Amen! I **Abraham Bullock** of the Borough of Stafford in the County of Stafford Basket Maker, being weak in Body, but of sound disposing Mind Memory and Understanding, Blessed be God for all his Mercies to me **Do** make publish and declare this my last Will and Testament in Manner and Form following (that is to say) **First** I give, bequeath and resign my Soul into the hands of Almighty God, and my Body to the Grave, and to be laid in a Coffin made by myself in the Year of our Lord 1752 at the Discretion of my Executors; **And** as to my Worldly Estate and Effects I give devise and bequeath as follows (namely) I give and devise to my Son **Isaac Bullock** all that Meadow or piece of Land situate at Tillington in the Parish of Saint Mary's Stafford in the County of Stafford known by the name of the Byflats formerly purchased from Hugo Meynel Esq. **To have and To hold** unto the said **Isaac Bullock** his heirs and assigns for ever **Item** I give and bequeath to my said Son **Isaac Bullock** Possession of all my other Osier Grounds, and also all my Shop Tools and my Stock in Trade Subject to the payment of my Debts and funeral expences **Item** I give and bequeath all and singular my household goods and furniture and other my personal Estate and Effects with the Possession of the House and premises wherein I now Dwell Unto the Children of my late Daughter **Hannah Flattery** share and share alike And I do hereby constitute and appoint my said Son **Isaac Bullock** and **John Bromley** Executors of this my Last Will and Testament, Thereby revoking all former Wills by me at any time heretofore me **In Witness** Whereof I, **Abraham Bullock** the Testator have hereunto set my hand and Seal this seventh Day of September in the Year of our Lord one Thousand eight Hundred and Six
