THIS IS THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT of me **GEORGE KETTLE** of 23 The Grove Eccles in the County of Lancaster I hereby revoke all wills and testamentary instruments heretofore by me made I APPOINT **Hubert Victor Kettle** of 23 The Grove Eccles now serving with His Majesty's Forces Driver Royal Field Artillery and **Phillis Humphries** of 118 Glossop Road Gamesley Nr Glossop Derbyshire to be the EXECUTORS of this my Will I direct my Executors to pay my Just Debts and Funeral and Testamentary Expense I give and bequeath to my wife **Elizabeth Kettle** everything I possess WITNESS my hand this Second day of February 1918
